## GIMP Black and White Coloring

You will be using GIMP to color Two (2) different black and white images. Both images can be selected using the “Activities Folder.” The point of this assignment is to make your hand colored image look as realistic as possible; you will try to make the colors look like they are there naturally. Please do not simply scribble a rainbow over the images, try to use the images and make them look like it could actually exist somewhere else.

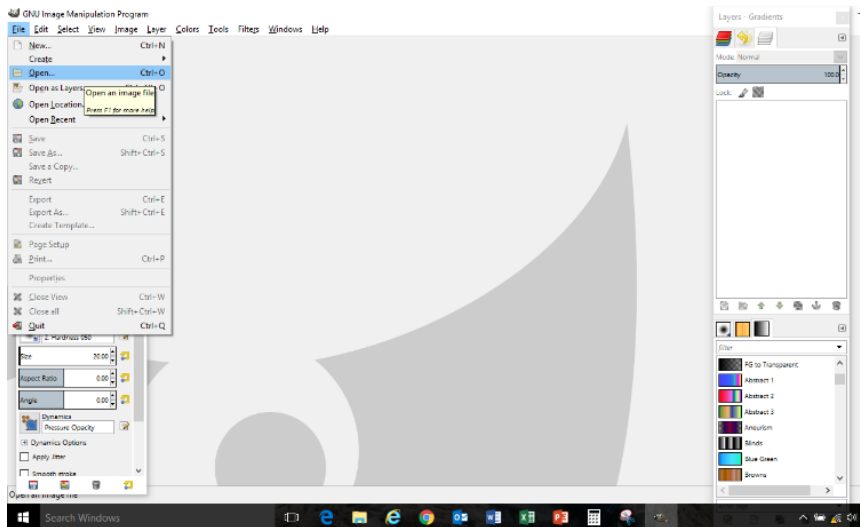
DUE DATE IMAGE 1: DUE April 5th

DUE DATE IMAGE 2: DUE April 19<sup>th</sup>

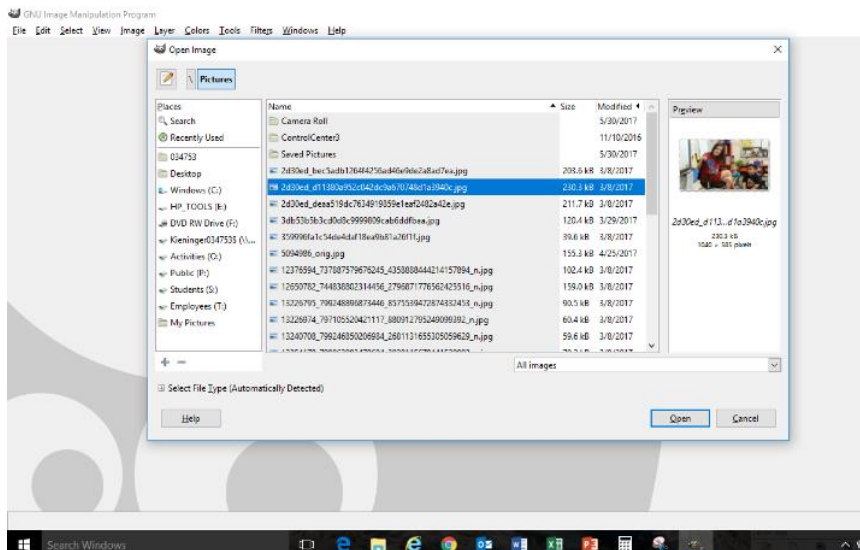

### 1)Open Image

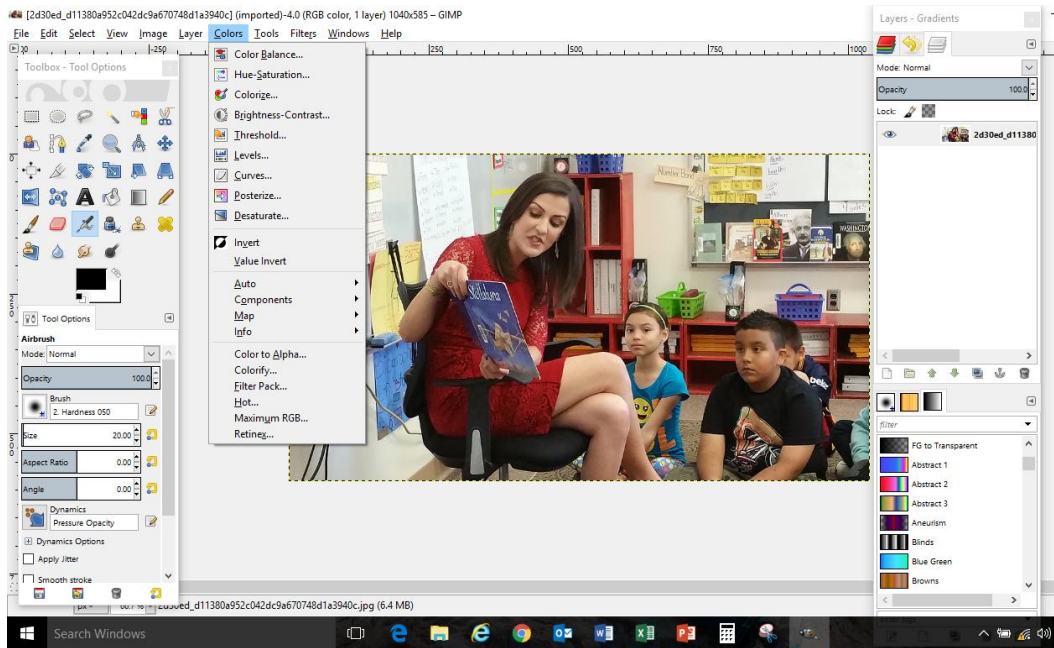


### 2) Select Your Image

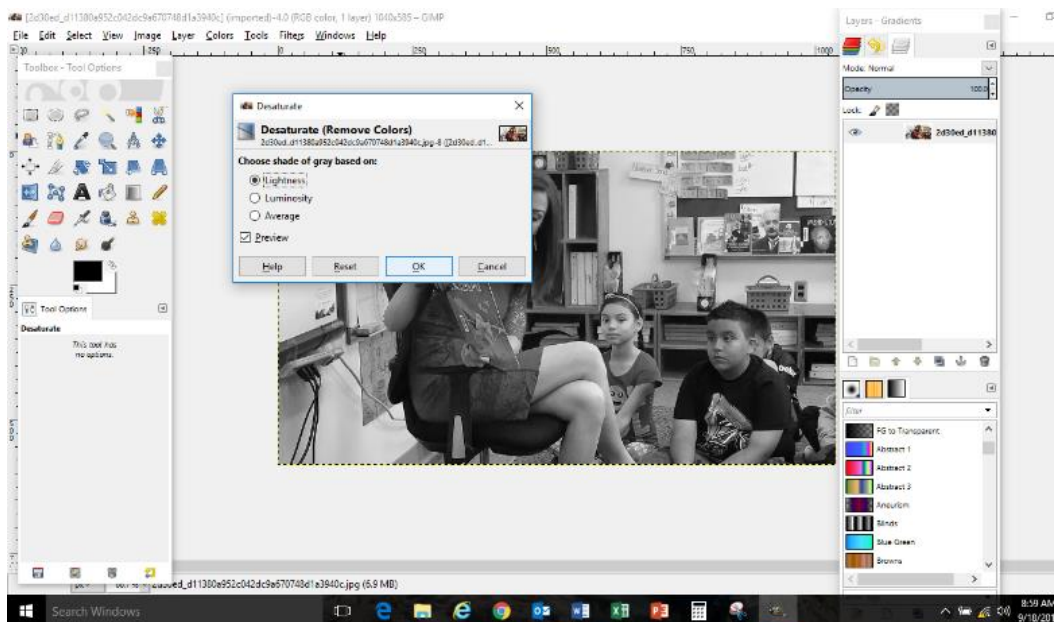
